	Water 55.90% Ethanol 40.0% Glycerin 2.00% Coco Diethanolamide 1.50% Triclosan 0.50% Methyl Salicylate 0.10%
<b>SECTION 3</b>	<b>HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION</b>
	Ethanol is considered a "dangerous" substance under the EU directive 68/547/EEC (as amended) - Inflammable
<b>SECTION 4</b>	<b>FIRST AID MEASURES</b>
EYES	Flush eyes and under eyelids immediately with water for at least 15 minutes, to ensure complete removal. If any irritation persists, seek medical advice.
INGESTION	Should any liquid be swallowed drink plenty of water and seek medical advice immediately
INHALATION	Not normally a problem as the product is incorporated into a wipe. Over-exposure: if inhaled remove person to fresh air
SKIN	Not normally a problem as product is designed for skin contact Over-exposure: Wash with soap and water
<b>SECTION 5</b>	<b>FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES</b>
	Inflammable substance. Fire-fighting: use water, foam, carbon dioxide to extinguish. Fire fighters should wear breathing apparatus.

	Leaks or spillages not normally a problem due to the nature of the product. Should any quantity of liquid escape – remove all sources of ignition. Flush the area with water.
